

Using the Bachelor of Arts Study Plan: Adding Breadth

The [Study Plan](#) lays out your course in a tree diagram. There are components in your Study Plan for major(s), electives, breadths, as well as for minors where applicable. These components can be expanded to reveal subjects or further components. This guide will show you how to add a breadth component to a Bachelor of Arts study plan for a standard major so that you can add and enrol into a breadth subject to your plan. You can access the study plan via my.unimelb.edu.au.

Tip: Use the [University Handbook](#) to identify the subjects, majors or streams that are available and follow the course requirements.

STEP 1:

Select 'Choose' on the Breadth, Majors and Minors section on the study plan.

STEP 2:

Select 'Breadth or non-standard major/minor' from the drop down search menu and select 'Search'.

- Either Breadth, or a non-standard Major/Minor : 1 must be selected
- 1 Major, with an optional Second Major : 1 must be selected
- No more than 1 Minor : 1 may be selected

STEP 3:

To add the Breadth and Free Points section to your plan, select 'Add to Study Planner'.

- 1 Major, with an optional Second Major : 1 must be selected

STEP 4:

After adding the Breadth and Free section to your Study Planner, select 'Save' which is located in the bottom left hand corner. This will return you to the Study Plan.

→ **Note:** if you are completing a non-standard major such as Psychology, Economics or Chinese Studies (Entry Point 1), the breadth requirements are different from a standard major and you should select the non-standard major accordingly. This will populate the relevant breadth section.

STEP 5:

Your study plan will now have a Breadth and Free Points section where you can now add and enrol into Breadth subjects. To do this, select 'Choose' in the new Breadth and Free Points sub-section.

→ **Note:** Please check the breadth requirement rules as stated in the [Handbook](#) based on your intended major (standard or non-standard). A standard major will require a minimum of 50 points of breadth subjects within the Breadth and Free Points section of the study plan.

STEP 6:

If you know the subject code/name of the breadth subject, enter the subject code/name of the breadth subject in the search bar and select 'Search'. To add the subject to your study plan, Select 'Add to Study Planner'.

Breadth and Free Points  75 Credit Points must be selected

All of the following rules must be satisfied:

- Between 50 and 75 points of Breadth : 50 credit points must be selected
- Between 12.5 and 37.5 points of level 1 Breadth : 12.50 credit points must be selected
- No more than 25 points of Arts Discipline : 25 credit points may be selected
- No more than 50 points of level 1 subjects : 50 credit points may be selected
